

DEPARTMENT 17 — FLORAL EXHIBITS

1. The use of or displaying of artificial flowers is prohibited and no premiums will be paid.
2. Plants positively will not be accepted for exhibition unless they have been growing in containers for two months.
3. The management will not undertake to return exhibits or be responsible for the return of exhibits. Baskets or containers must be clean and be supplied by the exhibitor and will be given every possible care, but the management assumes no responsibility for their safety.
4. Flowers or plants entered for competition must be more than ordinary standard quality to be entitled to an award.
5. All entries must be grown by the exhibitor. Entries will be accepted on Sunday, Aug. 20th ONLY from 1 to 5 p.m. in the tile building.
6. All flowers MUST be entered in a vase or glass jar. NO paper or plastic cups will be accepted.
7. Entries will not be accepted from individuals who are professional florists or in their employment.
8. Only two entries per class per exhibitor will be accepted.
9. The Pennsylvania Gladiolus Society will conduct its annual show at the fair. Exhibits of named (numbered) varieties will be judged by a NAGC judge. Judging will take place after entries close on Sunday. Recognition will be provided by the Pennsylvania Gladiolus Society.

1. Exhibits in this division must be cut flowers grown by the exhibitor and must conform to the number of blooms, spikes or stems specified in each class. Exhibits will be disqualified if specified number of specimens are not exhibited.

2. All flowers MUST be entered in a vase or glass jar. NO paper or plastic cups will be accepted.

3. The uniformity of height, color or size is an important factor in evaluating entries.

4. Flowers in each entry must be of one color and variety unless stated otherwise.

5. Use of a standard "vaselike" container to fit the specimen(s). No over sized or undersized containers.

6. Gladiolus exhibitors classes 1301 & 1302 are limited to non PA Gladiolus Society Members

2. All flowers MUST be entered in a vase or glass jar. NO paper or plastic cups will be accepted.
3. Uniformity of height, color or size is an important factor in evaluating entries.
4. Flowers in each entry must be of one color and variety unless otherwise stated.
5. Use a standard "vase like" container to fit the specimen(s). No over- sized or undersized containers.
6. No bush or tree flowers will be accepted.
