2024 RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. A pen fee of \$5 per head is required with registration. There will be no refunds for no-show sheep exhibits. If an animal to be exhibited becomes sick a refund may be granted if a slip is obtained from a vet.
- 2. Livestock must be pre-registered by August 1. Livestock are to arrive on Monday, Aug. 19 between noon and 9 p.m. They must remain on exhibit until released at 10:30 p.m., Saturday, Aug. 24.
- 3. Yearlings born 1/1/23 to 12/31/23 may have no more than 4 permanent teeth showing at show time. Fall lambs born 9/1/23 to 12/31/23 may have yearling teeth present, but they must not be even with lamb teeth at show time. Spring lambs born on or after 1/1/24 to 5/31/24 must have all lamb teeth.
- 4. When sheep housing is full, entries will be refused based on latest postmark date. Note item 15 of General Rules and Regulations.
- 5. All sheep must bear an official USDA/APHIS ear tag or tattoo to be exhibited at the show. Sheep from flocks or the voluntary scrapie program must bear the official ear tag or electronic ear implant.
- 6. The combining of two breeders to establish a group class is not permitted.
- 7. A show order will be established by the committee. It will be the exhibitor's responsibility to get a copy of the show order.
- 8. The "Other" breed category is for exhibitors of recognized breeds that are not identified by a listed breed category.

- 1. A pen fee of \$4 per head is required with registration. No refunds for no show lamb exhibits. If an animal to be exhibited becomes sick a refund may be granted if a slip is obtained from a vet.
- Lambs must be pre-registered by August 1. Limited space is available. All lamb entries will be accepted in the order they
 are received according to their postmark until all pens are filled. Lambs are to arrive on Sunday, Aug. 18 between 10 a.m.
 and 6 p.m. They must remain on exhibit until released at 10:30 p.m., Saturday, Aug. 24. Weigh-in will be Monday, Aug 19
 at 8 a.m.
- 3. Exhibitors must read and refer to the Open Youth Market Animal General Rules. Rules 8 through 14 list the limits of market animal projects to be shown and sold. Entries may be limited due to space availability.
- 4. The animal(s) must be under the ownership and the care of the club member.
- 5. All animals will be tagged at weigh-in with an 840 US coded official EID tag along with a sequential visual tag denoting the program.
- 6. Weigh-in/tagging will be at the Hookstown Fair Grounds.
- 7. All animals must be castrated (for Males), dehorned, and/or disbudded prior to weigh-in/tagging date.
- 8. To be eligible to show and sell at the Hookstown Fair the minimum and maximum weight for Lambs is 90 160 lbs.
- All lambs must be slick shorn before show date.
- 10. All animals must be marketable quality as determined by show/sale committee.

DEPARTMENT 10 4-H AND VOCATIONAL

Eligibility: 4-H club members must have passed their eighth birthday but must not have passed their 19th birthday as of January 1st. Exhibitors must be 4-H members carrying a project in the field in which they wish to make entry and be under the supervision of their State University Cooperative Extension Service by their designated deadline. Open Class rules, regulations and entry times apply for all 4-H and Vocational Livestock Projects. All animals shown by a 4-H exhibitor must be owned by that exhibitor or have a lease agreement and must be carried as a 4-H project. Be sure to use only grooming products that are approved for use on meat and dairy animals when fitting your animals for show. Unapproved products may contain ingredients that result in unacceptable residues in the meat or milk. For exhibits, including live animals, please refer to the Beaver County 4-H Project Directory and/or the project book for project completion requirements not listed on the website or Department 10 information printed from the website. Sheep Health Rules and Requirements

All animals showing clinical signs of contagious, infectious, or parasitic diseases will not be admitted to any show or other fair event.

All drug and vaccine labels directions must be followed, including but not limited to milk and slaughter withdrawal periods. The vaccine must be administered at least 15 days prior to entry into the fair.

A movement record with a specific set of information needs to be included on the sales slip which travels with the sheep to any final destination-including slaughter. A copy of those records will need to be kept and retained for a period of 5 years to meet the requirements of the new federal scrapie rules.

Pennsylvania Sheep Requirements:

- 1. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued after May 1, 2024 is required.
- 2. All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases and a statement of this is required on the CVI (the statement is pre-printed on the CVI).
- 3. Individual official USDA scrapie animal identification is required. Official scrapie ID includes:
 - A USDA ear tag with a US shield (iii); or
 - A legible tattoo with herd and individual identification recognized in an approved USDA Scrapie database a.k.a. scrapie tattoo (only for herds enrolled in the USDA Voluntary Scrapie Herd Certification Program); or
 - A breed registration tattoo if the animal is accompanied by a registration certificate and the tattoo is legible.
- 4. A current rabies vaccination administered by a licensed veterinarian is recommended for animals 3 months of age and older.

Out of State Sheep Requirements:

- 1. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued within the 60 days prior to entry into PA is required.
- 2. Vesicular Stomatitis (VS): (applies to states that experienced a Vesicular Stomatitis outbreak in the last 12 months). An accredited veterinarian shall determine whether the animals are free from VS, and animals shall be accompanied by a CVI with the following statement signed by the accredited veterinarian: "All animals identified on this certificate of veterinary inspection have been examined and found to be free from Vesicular Stomatitis (VS). During the past 90 days; these animals were not located within 10 miles of a site where VS has been diagnosed."
- 3. All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases and a statement of this is required on the CVI (the statement is pre-printed on the CVI).
- 4. Individual official animal identification is required for all goats includes:
 - A USDA ear tag with a US shield (iii); or
 - A legible tattoo with herd and individual identification recognized in an approved USDA Scrapie database a.k.a. scrapie tattoo (only for herds enrolled in the USDA Voluntary Scrapie Herd Certification Program); or
 - A breed registration tattoo if the animal is accompanied by a registration certificate and the tattoo is legible.
- 5. A current rabies vaccination administered by a licensed veterinarian is recommended for animals 3 months of age and older.
